

**Born in Wells, Somerset but raised primarily in the Middle East, Ilona developed a love of home-made Indian food from a young age. Adult years travelling to India solidified her passion for small batch, authentically-spiced curries, dals and pilau rice dishes.**

Almost two decades spent honing her skills, her start was making a batch of lime pickle in 2004 in Pittsburgh, PA USA - a 3-4 week process but the resulting product was unlike anything store bought she'd ever tasted. Mango chutney, garlic pickle and lemon pickle followed. She learnt to make the curries, dals and rice to accompany the pickles bringing back the products she needed from her work as an airline stewardess. The reward - to introduce and share her love of Indian food with others.

After 40 years in the airline industry, Ilona lost her job due to the closure of her airline caused by the COVID-19 pandemic.

Repatriating to the UK after many years abroad and following studies for a Certificate in Culinary Arts at **Ashburton Chef's Academy** in South Devon, she was given a wonderful opportunity to start a food pop-up in what was Lacey's Tea Rooms at 10 Lee Road, Lynton.

Ilona created a take-away and eat-in in a 'bring-your-own' dining room experience using seasonal local produce from local farm shops where available. All home-made small batch authentically-spiced dishes flavoured with her own blends of spice masalas to recreate the local food of India.

As part of the drive to be more green, an exciting new concept of how to share this food more seamlessly and productively was born.

Even now, whenever I go back home, I like to spend time in my dad's kitchen cooking next to him. My dad has always inspired me, and has been in the kitchen with me to help guide and develop my creativity and skills. More recently I have been inspired by Peter Gordon, Yotam Ottolenghi, Alex Jackson and many others that have made food their passion.

I have adopted many cooking styles but love to cook long and slow for meat and some vegetarian dishes. I also like the fast and furious approach during service - this combination gives the best result on a plate.

At the Vanilla Pod we focus on Eastern Mediterranean and Middle Eastern regions. We are also known for serving "Food with Mediterranean beat". The sun-drenched style of cooking of the whole Mediterranean Sea is so vibrant and diverse that it gives you endless inspiration and drive to create more.

I firmly believe that my passion for Middle Eastern cuisine found me when I was a child. I was cooking shakshuka even before I knew that such dishes existed thanks to my uncle and his friends from the Jewish community,



it was simply called eggs with tomatoes back then.

When I'm not cooking or managing the Vanilla Pod I love exploring where I live with my family. Exmoor National Park is a place that can bring life back into your body and soul after long hours of work. Regularly venturing into the wild with my dog Hugo has become a necessity, it allows me to reconnect with nature and myself. The North Devon coastline, woodlands and moors, together with the inspiring people that I have met, have embarked me on to the extraordinary exploration of the world of wild food. It takes me back to my childhood and fond memories of foraging with my dad.

I would love to find a way of passing on my knowledge and passion of food to others. What I love best is to inspire people to discover, appreciate and celebrate the incredible abundance of joy that food gives you in life. In the words of one chef "life is meant to be celebrated and what is a celebration without great food", I could not agree more.

## A May's Farm is an Exmoor family-run farm, selling beef, pork and lamb with pride.

A May's Farm officially came into being in late 2021 when Alex and Anne bought their own farm at Blackmoor Gate, but in reality, it has been developing for as long as they have been on Exmoor together.

Alex is a fourth-generation farmer on Exmoor, he has always had a passion for farming and livestock. During university he travelled to New Zealand and Australia to learn about their farming techniques. Anne has more of an environmental background and brings a different skillset to the farm. They live and farm at Slattenslade Farm in Woody Bay, their children are growing up on the same farm as Alex.



The Stabiliser beef cattle, Exmoor Mule sheep and rare breed pigs are farmed on rotational grazing systems. This improves grazing quality, animal welfare and has numerous environmental benefits. They have focussed on farming animal breeds that grow well here and that have been bred for meat quality and flavour. Welfare and traceability of the animals are very important.



Homegrown beef, pork and lamb are sold fresh (when available) and frozen in boxes, mixed boxes and as individual joints and cuts. Collections can be made from the farm, with drop offs locally, or via post for those further afield.



## THE LAST NARROW-GAUGE RAILWAY ADVENTURE

Originally opened in 1898, and closed in 1935; what you can see today at Woody Bay is just the beginning of an exciting project to rebuild one of the world's most famous and picturesque narrow-gauge railways; the legendary Lynton & Barnstaple Railway.

You board your train, comprised of restored heritage carriages, at Woody Bay Station, and travel to Killington Lane and back on a two-mile round trip

behind a narrow-gauge steam locomotive.

The complete trip lasts about 25 minutes. Tickets are valid all day so you can ride as many times as you like. Return anytime within 28 days and travel all day at half-price.

This initial section allows our visitors to experience a taste of what will one day become one of the ultimate narrow-

gauge treasures of the world as they once again travel by train along the original route above the delightful Heddon Valley near Parracombe in the Exmoor National Park.
